

The Jack Jamesen Memorial Sculpture Park ^{501 c(3)}, so far displays figurative bronze sculptures by local artists: the late Leslie Demille, Susan Kliever, James N. Muir, John Soderberg, Ph.D. And Lita Toritch. The next major purchase by the Friends of Jack Jamesen Memorial Sculpture Park will be a life size bronze titled “Athena’s Prayer” by James N. Muir. This piece depicts a modern Athena just returned from war. The piece honors all women, those who have served in our armed forces, those on active duty in our military and those who work daily in every other field to carry out their chosen duties.
